

#### Will You Drive the Church Bus?

<u>Requirements</u>: Men and women, 21 years and older, are needed and welcome to drive. Drivers don't need to stay with the children once your drop them off, but they are certainly welcome. Drivers do not need to possess a CDL (certified driver's license) to drive this size bus, but they would need to have a clean driving record, be approved by the church's insurance company, and pass a background screening, if they have not had one done for the church during the past year.
