Obion County Schools Backpack Program

The Obion County Backpack Program was started 12 years ago by Director of Coordinated School Health Chastity Homra. Since then, she still assists with the program which has been helped by local churches. In the county system, there are five elementary schools that have a food program: South Fulton Elementary School, Lake Road Elementary School, Ridgemont Elementary School, Black Oak Elementary School, and Hillcrest Elementary School. Within each school, the Guidance teachers help with distributing the food to the families that are in need.

The program is done by an as need basis. The staff at the schools' work with families to get permission to obtain the bags sent home weekly. The bags are packed and brought to the schools by the churches that help in the surrounding area. This program is done all year long, and we try to give extra during times the school will be out for breaks and holidays.

Any donations are appreciated to help this program continue to be successful in our school system. Our families appreciate the assistance that they receive from our schools.
