OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOEBOX COLLECTION

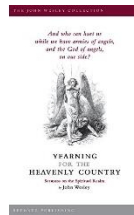

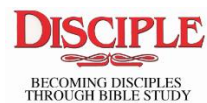
